

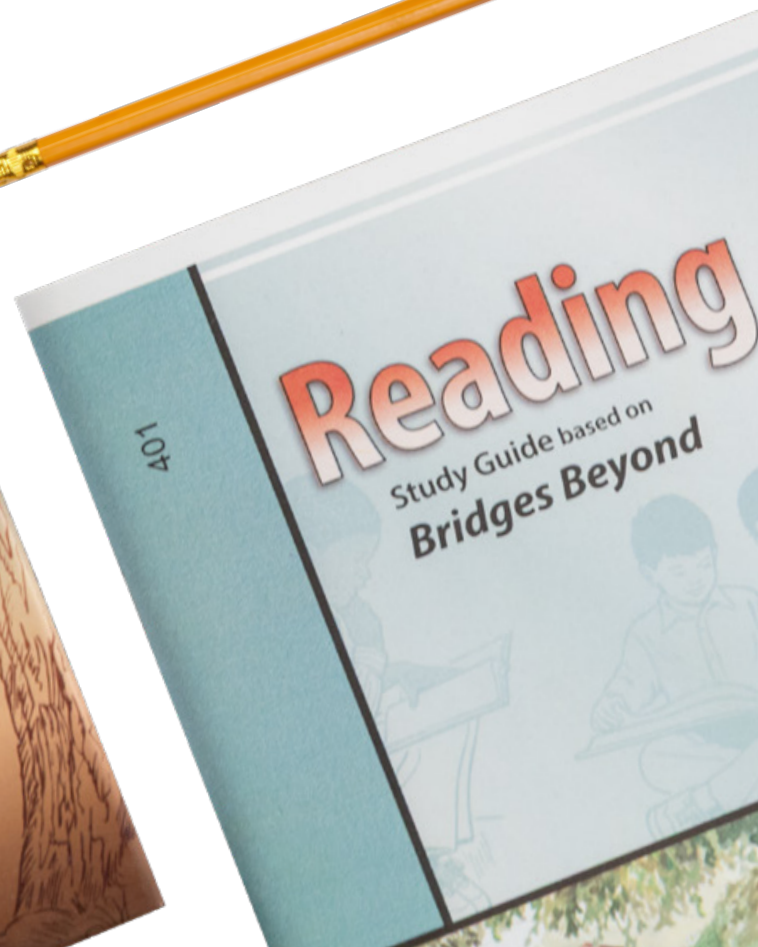
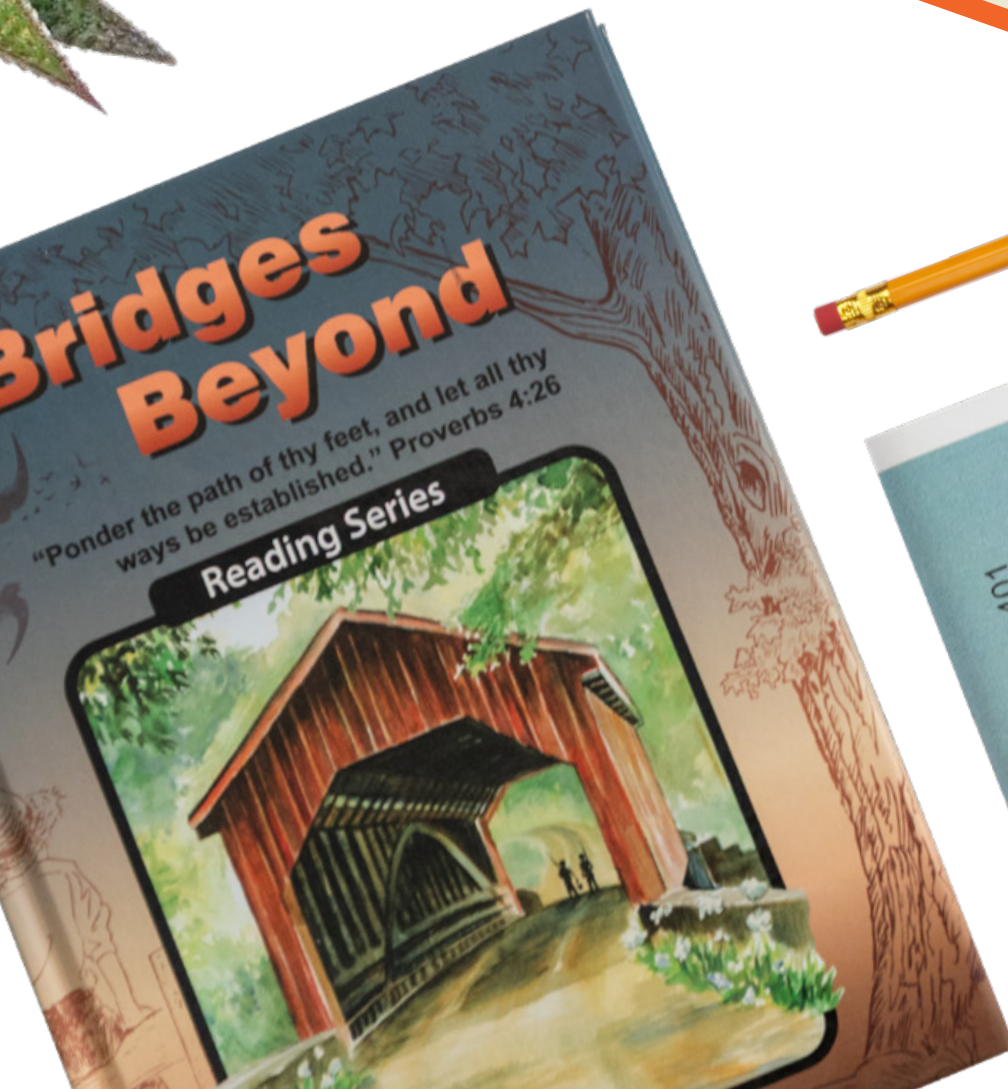

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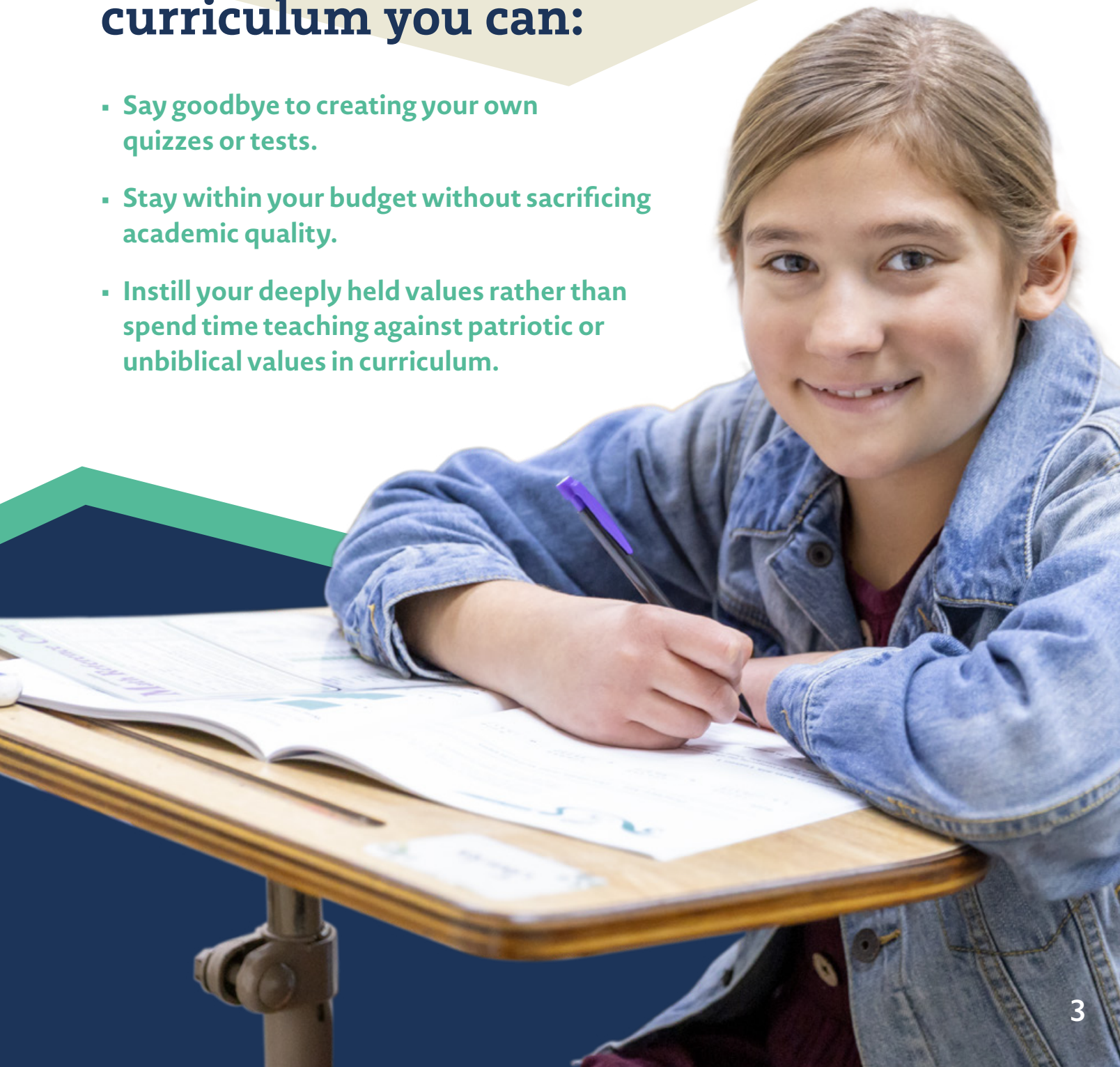

Getting to Know OUR FORMAT

What is a LightUnit?

A LightUnit is a workbook that includes exercises, quizzes, and test all in one. The lesson text is also in the LightUnit, except for Reading and some Social Studies courses. The quizzes are perforated sheets in the back of the workbook, and the final test is stapled into the center. Remove the quizzes and the test before handing the LightUnit to your student.

A LightUnit typically contains fifteen to seventeen days of student work. A full one-credit course usually consists of ten Light-Units. Some courses consist of five LightUnits.

Non-Sunrise Edition

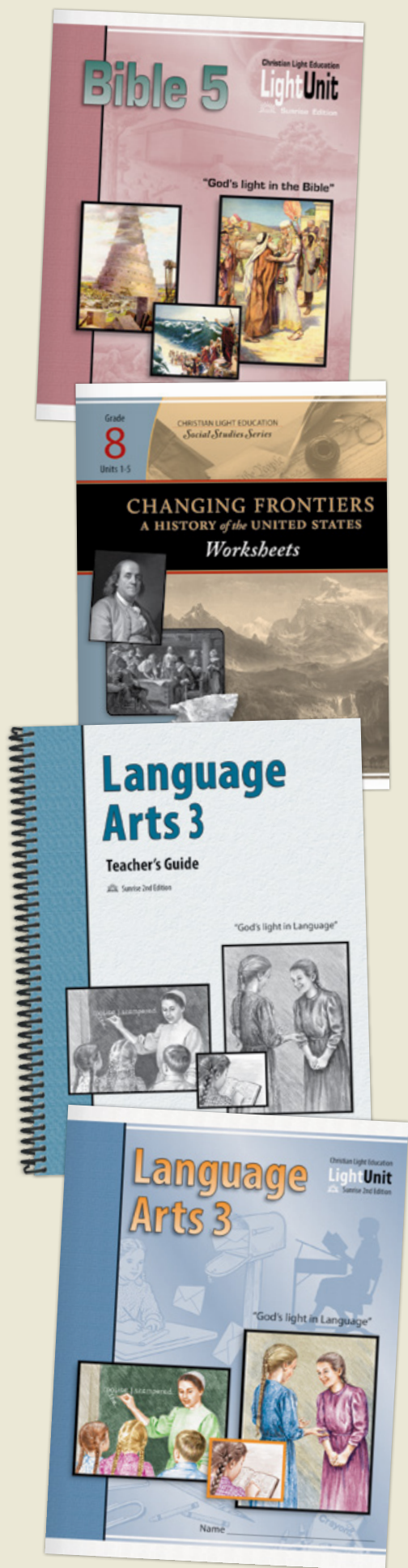

Study Guide LightUnits

A Study Guide LightUnit does not contain the lesson text. Rather, it accompanies a textbook or reader and provides only exercises, quizzes, and a test.

What are Worksheets?

A few courses have a worksheet option as an alternative to LightUnits. Worksheets accompany a textbook or reader and are designed for classrooms where teachers are more actively



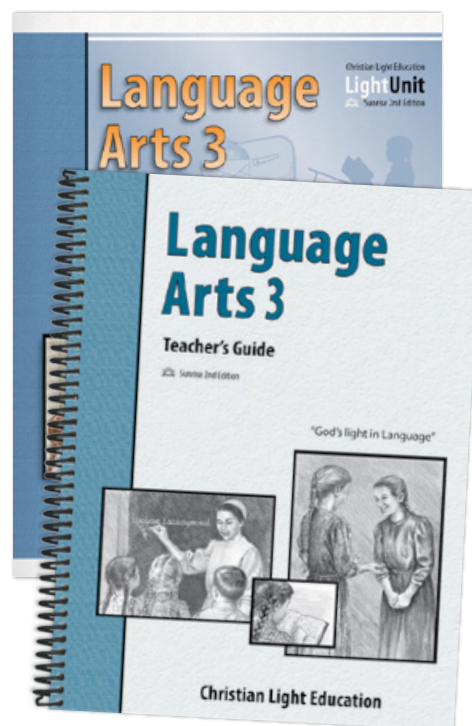
involved in providing instruction and review. Students complete a two-sided worksheet that covers the textbook material of the lesson. The worksheets are bound in two booklets. Quizzes and tests are sold separately as a pack. Currently we offer worksheets for Grades 6, 7 & 8 Social Studies, Grades 2 & 3 Reading, and Literature 1.

What is included in Teacher's Guides?

The content of Teacher's Guides varies but typically includes review questions, instructions for teaching new concepts, and appendixes with scope and sequences and alternate LightUnit tests. Lesson plans in lower-grade Sunrise Teacher's Guides are more detailed than those in higher grades. Many Sunrise Teacher's Guides contain student pages with the answers filled in (math Teacher's Guides include solutions).

Do I need to buy Answer Keys?

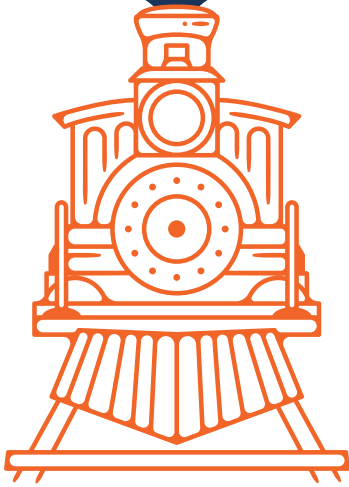

How It Works

Sunrise Edition curriculum uses a spiral learning method. Here is how it works to make learning easier for students:

Incremental teaching. In language arts, math, and reading, new material is introduced in small steps, making the learning process less overwhelming and more efficient.

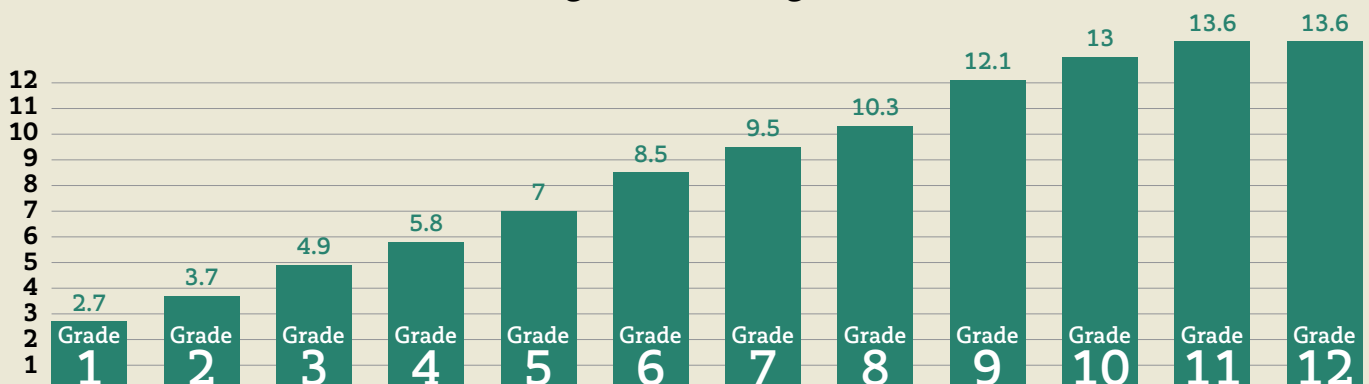
Students' daily work is based on a 30-to-70 ratio, with approximately 30 percent of the exercises being new material and 70 percent being review material. The "learning thread" on a particular concept is simple in the beginning and expanded in later lessons so that learning is cumulative.

Picture a train winding up and around a mountain. For example, the fraction train starts in Grade 1 with cars carrying a light load of simple fractions. As the train winds up and around the track, it pauses at stations, filling the cars that were partially filled with more difficult concepts about fractions and adding new cars carrying small loads of new concepts. The train chugs to the top a few years later with cars filled with facts and concepts.

Systematic continuous review. Part of the incremental approach is a system of continuous, comprehensive review. After a concept is introduced, students review it multiple times through exercises in following lessons. Students gain mastery by continually reviewing concepts.

Students Using Christian Light Curriculum

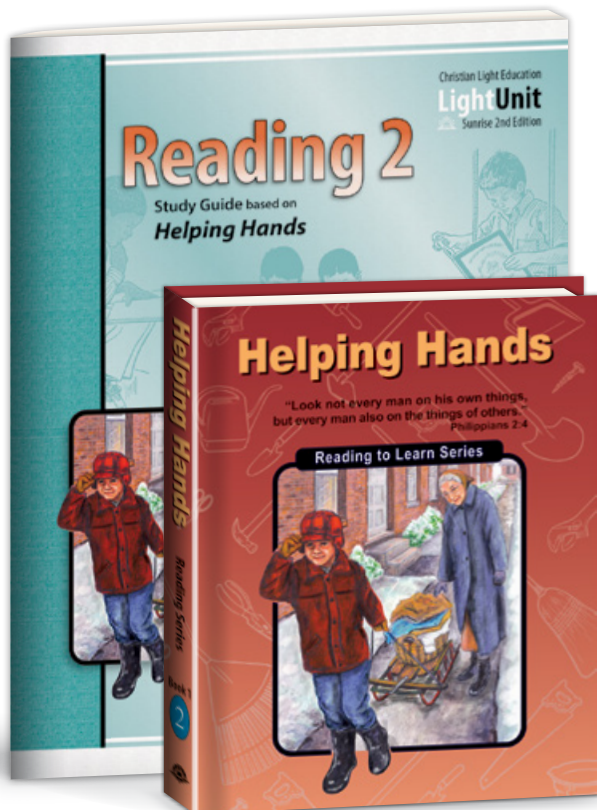

Reading well is an essential life skill. In addition to fostering a lifelong love of reading, Christian Light's Reading program helps students develop the reading and analytical thinking skills they need in today's world. With a foundation of good stories and poems, the curriculum emphasizes vocabulary, comprehension, and literary elements, techniques, and genres.



Overview

Christian Light Reading begins with Learning to Read, our comprehensive phonics-based reading program (pages 28 & 29). Phonics continues in Language Arts 1 & 2. After Learning to Read, first-grade students are ready to begin with the reader *I Wonder* in Reading 1. Reading 1 focuses on comprehension and oral reading with limited phonics review.

Grades 2 & 3 each have ten LightUnits to accompany their hardcover readers. Teacher's Guides contain aids to teaching and are integral to Grades 1-3.

Grades 4-8 consist of one reader and five LightUnits per grade. This lighter workload allows more subjects to be studied while still honing reading comprehension and literary analysis. The average student can complete most of the work with little teacher help.

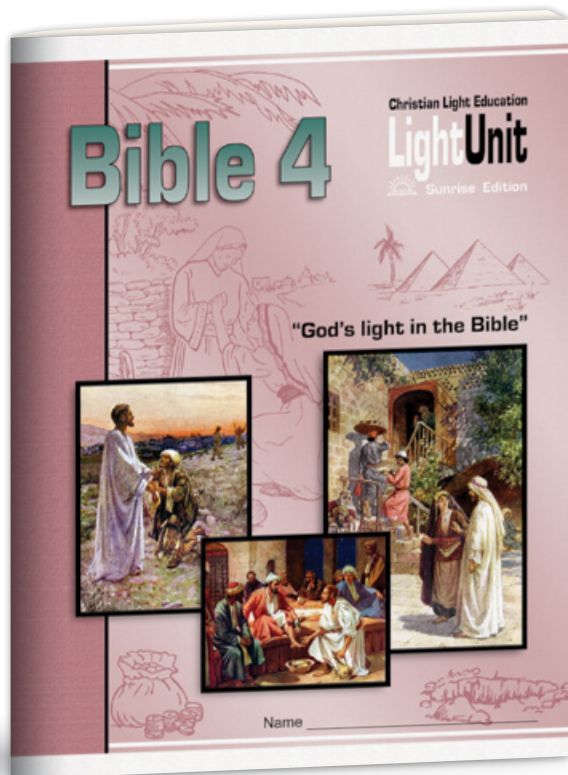

Bible

that deepens
knowledge of God

The goal of our Bible program is to point students to Jesus Christ, strengthen their love for the Word, and deepen their desire to surrender their hearts in devotion to Him. Students will gain a thorough knowledge of Bible facts and increase their understanding of and appreciation for God's timeless principles.



Overview

In the lower levels, Christian Light Bible teaches Bible stories in chronological order, introducing simple truths along with Bible history, geography, and cultures of the Old and New Testaments.

Sunrise Bible is available in Grades 1-9, but is an optional subject in the first two grades. There are no quizzes or tests in Grades 1 & 2, giving students the opportunity to develop a positive attitude toward Bible learning without pressure. Grades 3-9 follow the Sunrise format of lessons, quizzes, and a final test.

The Bible stories in elementary levels are retold in fresh, readable language that brings the Bible to life for students. Realistic pencil drawings illustrate most stories.

Grades 10-12 are being developed to fit the Sunrise model. Until then, these grade levels consist of ten self-study LightUnits. A day's work consists of selected Bible readings and corresponding exercises. Students can complete most lessons on their own.

The Sunrise Language Arts program provides tools for communicating with clarity and purpose. More than simply teaching proper grammar and punctuation, we strive to equip students to become able writers, careful listeners, adept speakers, capable researchers, and lifelong students of positive, wise communication.



Overview

Grades 1 and 2 Language Arts are required to complete our phonics program begun in Learning to Read, but can also be used with any phonics-based learning-to-read program.

In Language Arts, students study grammar, language mechanics, and the use of resource books, while also becoming adept at researching and writing. Each day a new concept is introduced in a small easily mastered increment. A review section covers a variety of old and new increments to ensure mastery. The lesson ends with penmanship and spelling practice so that you do not need a separate spelling program.

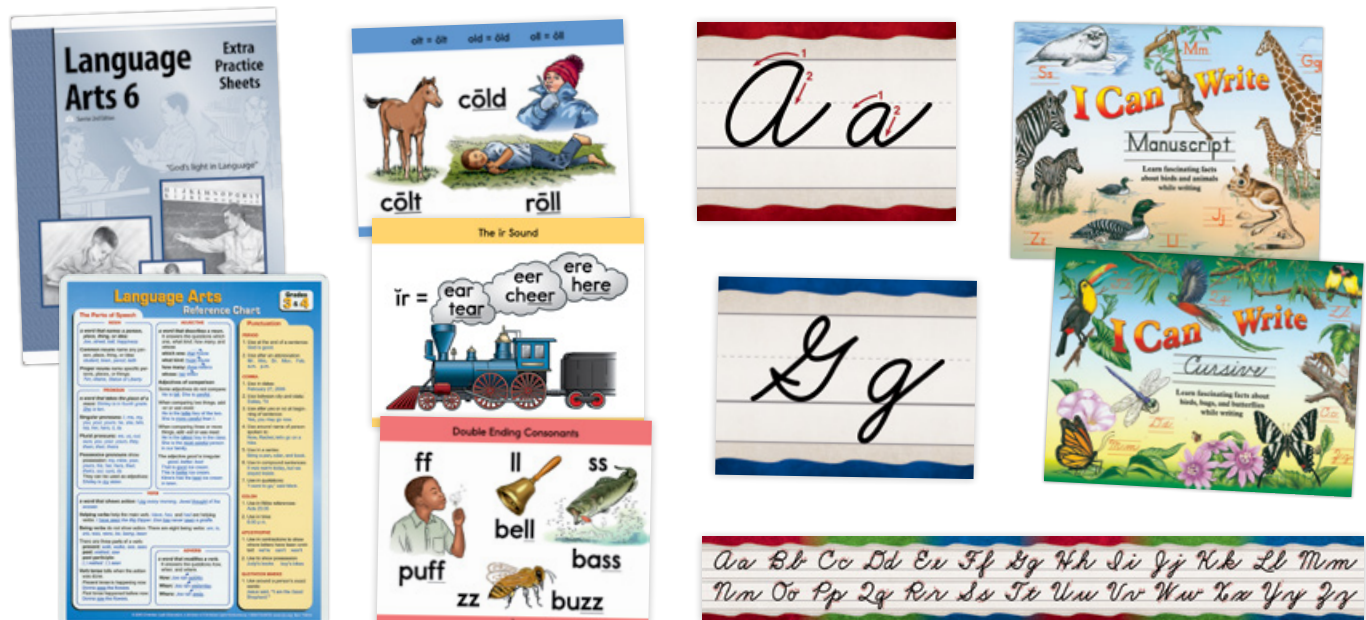
Creative writing assignments are included in the LightUnits in Sunrise 2nd Edition.

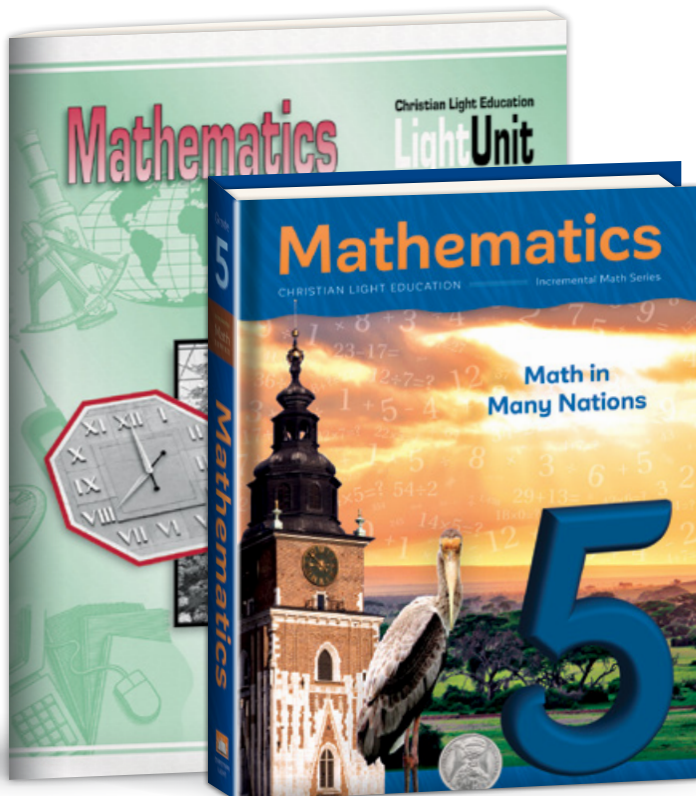
Perspectives of Life in Literature and Perspectives of Truth in Literature challenge high school students with selections from Bunyan, Frost, Hawthorne, and others (page 53).

Sunrise Math takes a systematic approach to learning. New concepts are introduced in small increments, followed by comprehensive daily review. Story problems and exercise themes promote Biblical values in finances, family living, and in our understanding of the created world.



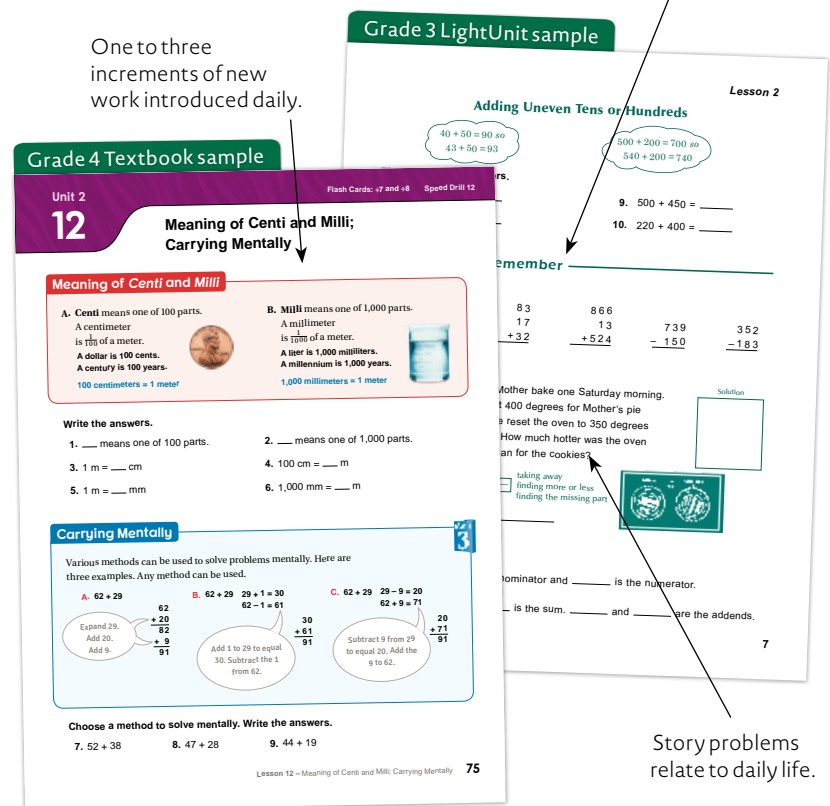
Overview

Strands such as geometry and algebra are introduced early to build a solid foundation.

Students learn the U.S. and metric measurement systems together to become proficient in both. The unique flash-card system, along with daily speed drills, helps students master basic facts with higher efficiency. We offer support items such as a counting chart, a clock with gears, and a calendar book, but most hands-on activities use simple items available anywhere.

For high school, only Algebra 1 and Algebra 2 (preliminary edition) are available in Sunrise Edition.

For Grades 4-9, two study options are available. Choose either the LightUnit or textbook format.



LightUnit Study Components

LightUnits Each consumable LightUnit workbook contains explanation of new concepts, student exercises, and a test. The first LightUnit in Grades 2-8 is a diagnostic review of the previous grade.

Teacher's Guides Teacher's Guides for Grades 1-8 have teacher tips and contain reproductions of the student LightUnit pages with solutions. Answer Keys for these grades are optional because answers are in the Teacher's Guides.

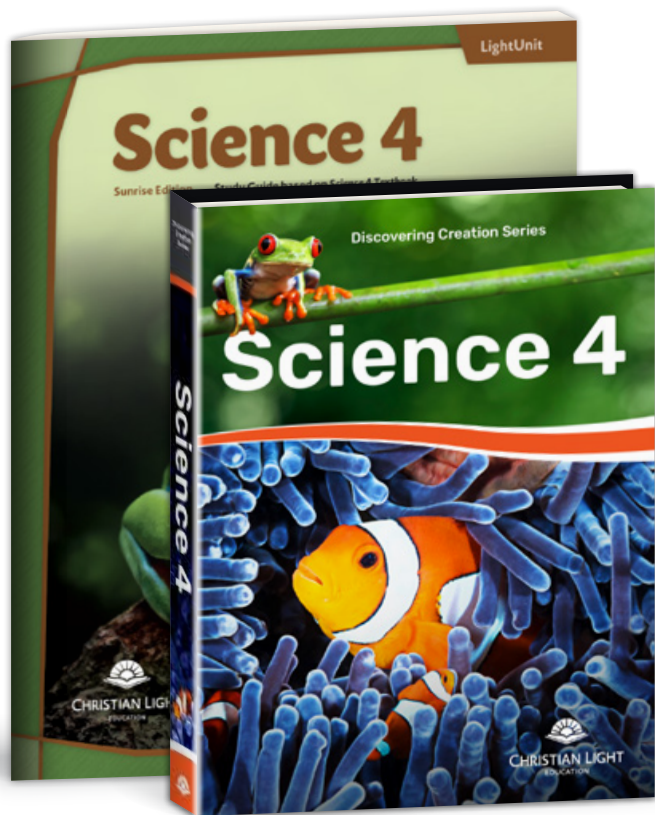

Christian Light Science takes students on a journey of exploration into the fascinating world of science. The study of the natural world and how things work is never complete without recognition of the awesome Creator who designed it all, from the intricacies of the atom to the infinity of space.



Overview

In elementary grades, Christian Light Science uses simple experiments along with workbook exercises to help students explore and learn scientific laws. Health studies are incorporated into Science. Science supplies for experiments are available from Home Science Tools®.

Grades 1, 2, 4, 5, and 6, and high school biology are available in Christian Light's Sunrise Edition format. All other grades are in the older format where the daily exercises are not divided into lessons and review is limited. Science is considered a supplemental course for Grades 1 and 2.

Grades 4, 5, and high school biology are based on a textbook. The other grades are LightUnit-based.

High school courses include general science, biology, chemistry, and physics. We offer some Apologia and Berean Builders courses as alternatives to our own while new Christian Light courses are being developed.

Ozone Layer

This special layer lies within the stratosphere. It is very important to us because it absorbs 97 to 99 percent of the sun's harmful ultraviolet radiation. Without the ozone layer, we would very quickly get a bad sunburn if we went outside during the day.

Ozone is formed when sunlight hits oxygen. Regular oxygen has two atoms per molecule, but ozone has three atoms per molecule.

Ozone molecule

Oxygen molecule

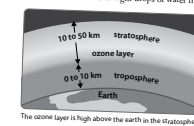
Although we talk about the "ozone layer," there is actually very little ozone in the ozone layer. There are two to eight ozone molecules per million molecules of air in the ozone layer. This is similar to two to eight drops of water in

an automobile's fuel tank. If all the ozone in the ozone layer was compressed to the pressure at sea level, it would only be about 3 millimeters (¼ in) thick. Even with so little ozone, it is still enough to protect us from most of the burning ultraviolet rays of the sun.

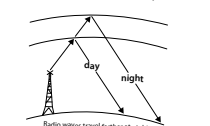
Ozone is poisonous because it has one more oxygen atom than regular oxygen molecules. Because of this, it is good the ozone layer is high placed in the stratosphere. How wonderful it is that God placed the ozone layer at just the right place to protect us!

Ionosphere

The ionosphere begins in the lower thermosphere and extends from about 90-480 km (57-300 mi) above the earth. The ionosphere is a layer of ionized air. Ions are electrically charged atoms of gas. As energy from sun rays strikes atoms, they become



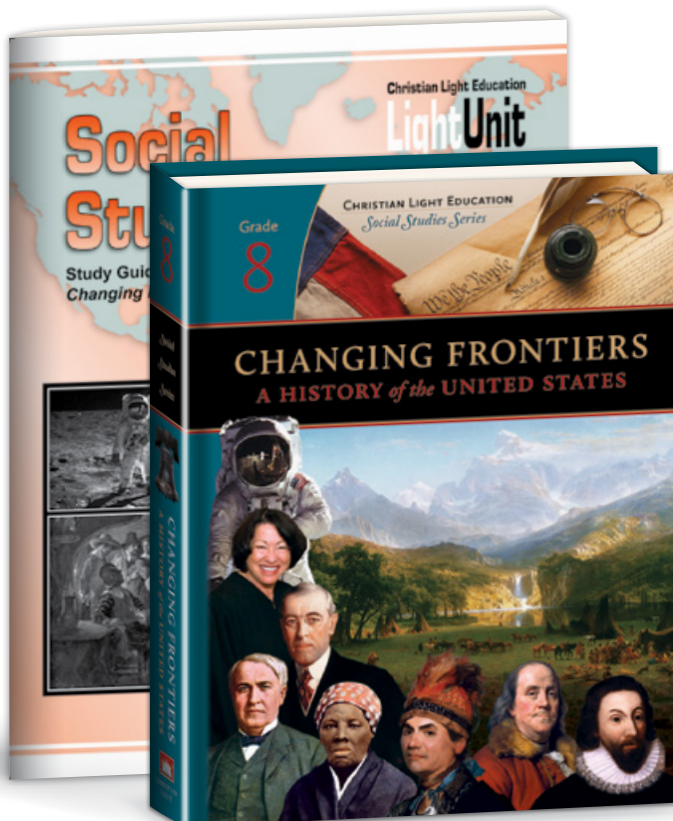
The ozone layer is high above the earth in the stratosphere.

Social Studies

from God's perspective

Christian Light Social Studies presents students with a Biblical view of God's dealings with mankind since the beginning of time. These courses recognize God's sovereign hand in history and His loving care for His people. Studying people and places, past and present, students will realize that the world is much larger and more complex than just their neighborhood.



Overview

A primary focus in our social studies is to prepare students for a life of service—serving God by strengthening the church, blessing the community, and fulfilling the Great Commission. Written from an Anabaptist perspective, these courses clearly teach the two-kingdom concept of separation between church and state.

In the first two grades, social studies is a supplemental course for students needing additional work.

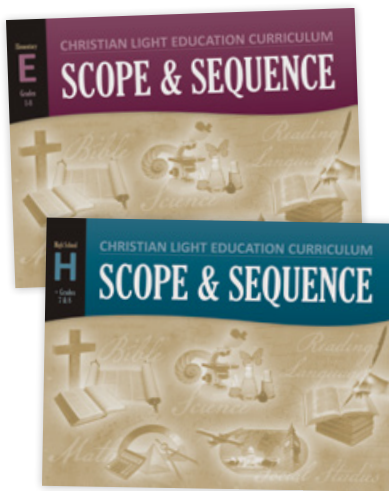
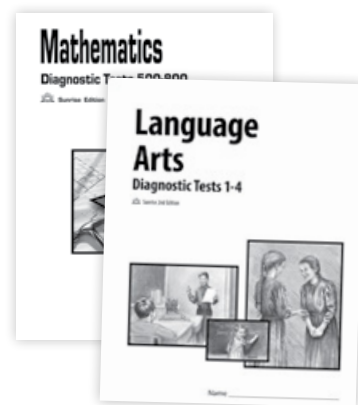
Diagnostic Tests

Graduation Requirements

When enrolled in Christian Light Academy, students can choose between three diploma levels to accommodate their interests, academic abilities, and vocational plans. The credit requirements for each course of study are given in the chart below.

Academic Diploma

The Academic diploma is recommended for students who are academically capable or who plan to go to college. All courses must be high school level, and a foreign language credit and physical education credit are required.

General Diploma

The General diploma does not require a foreign language credit and allows some eighth-grade courses to count for credit if they are completed in high school.

Vocational Diploma

The Vocational diploma accommodates students who struggle academically. This level does not require a foreign language or physical education credit and allows credit for some elementary courses if they are completed in high school.

Graduation Requirements for a High School Diploma

A student receives high school credit when he enters his ninth year of school or when he begins working in ninth grade material, whichever comes first. Credit cannot be earned for 5th - 8th grade work unless it is completed after the student enters ninth grade.

One credit = 10 LightUnits. One credit = 120 hours of classroom work or 240 hours of laboratory-type activity.
